During Bobs last meeting with the county the county staff said they had some complaints from the public regarding why we require park passes and AMA to fly at Waymer. The county's tentative plan is to allow NON AMA to fly at Waymer on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. The

consensus of the members present was to try and talk the county out of this plan by pointing out the various liability issues involved with their plan. the monies from the park pass has paid for several improvements to the field and should be continued for all flyers if possible. The club secretary will contact the AMA headquarters to seek guidance, and pass this info on to Bob for his next meeting with the county.

Terry gave the club an update on Lowe's flying field. He spoke at length with Roger at the speedway and Roger will be getting the flight stations set up ASAP. Terry asked for some one with an open trailer to volunteer to help move the tables to Lowe's from Jim G's place. He also said Roger wants the club members to keep an eye out for people driving down the access road towards the back of the camp ground area. Roger has deputized all club members to challenge these people. If the people refuse to leave call 911. The speedway has been having problems with people dumping and running dogs in the lower area.

Bob and Steve Nance made a proposal for an international large scale IMAC meet to be held at Lowe's in the spring of 2010. The general consensus of the members present was supportive of this event. More details to follow.

New business:

Bob Bauer made a report on Waymer ,please read his memo [here](#). He will be working with the county regarding the funding of the road gravel to be added around the back of the enclosure.

The aeromodeler advisory funds may be tapped for this purpose (these funds are generated by the \$20 field pass and were severely depleted by the paving of the runway). He also mentioned that a hand hold pylon for control line speed will be installed in the center of the #2 flying circle. The county wants to know why we require AMA to fly at Waymer (and We thought that was their Idea!?). Bob will be meeting with the county to school them on this issue.

Due to mutually busy work schedules, Terry has yet to contact Roger at Lowes regarding the official reopening the field there.

Don Stegall made a report about this summer's club 40 pylon racing. He will be staging these races on his dime, the club will be incurring no expenses. The races will be sanctioned by AMA and run under their rules. The course workers will be paid. He will be providing the club with new Pylons.

The dates for pylon racing at Lowes this summer were approved. The dates are: 6/6/09 ,7/11/09 ,7/25/09 ,8/8/09 ,8/22/09. the race in June may be held at Waymer.

A Flyin at Lowes on April 18 2009 was approved. It will be called: The second annual "Lowe's Spring Fling" Larry Moore will be the CD for the event.

A work day for Waymer was approved for this spring ,probably limited to a field FOD walk.

Terry proposed a Joint Flyin with Charlotte Aeromodelers located in Midland, NC. possibly this fall. no motions were made on this proposal.
